18 Petitioner American Civil Liberties Union of Nevada (“ACLU”) and Respondent Las
19 Vegas Metropolitan Police Department (“LVMPD”), stipulate to extend the current stay of this
20 matter an additional two weeks to November 28, 2025.

21 The parties continue to actively engage in discussions to resolve this matter without further
22 Court intervention. Since the Court entered the prior stay (Doc. 10), the only remaining issue to
23 resolve is ACLU's Attorneys' Fees and Costs for preparing and filing the Writ Petition. To
24 preserve the Court's limited resources and facilitate a resolution agreeable to both parties, the

1 parties seek a stay of this matter until November 28, 2025. The additional time will allow the
2 parties to meet and confer to address ACLU's Attorneys' Fees and Costs. The parties also seek to
3 continue the Status Check previously set by this Court from November 18, 2025, to December 2,
4 2025.

5 This Stipulation is made in good faith and not for the purpose of delay.

6 **ORDER**

7 Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that this matter is STAYED to November 28, 2025;

8 It is further ORDERED that the STATUS CHECK currently set for November 18, 2025,
9 is continued to December 2, 2025, at 9:00 A.M. for the parties to appear and advise the Court on
10 the status of their negotiations and steps moving forward.
