1 Plaintiffs-Petitioners (“Plaintiffs”) hereby file this motion for leave to file supplemental
 2 authorities relevant to the Court’s consideration of Plaintiffs’ Motion for Class Certification and
 3 Appointment of Class Counsel [ECF No. 15] and Plaintiffs’ Reply to Defendants’-Respondents’

8 Good cause exists to grant the motion. Since briefing concluded on both matters and a

 13 19, 2025) (order granting plaintiff’s motion for partial summary judgment);
- 14 • *Maldonado Bautista v. Santacruz*, No. 5:25-cv-01873-SSS-BFM, 2025 LX 523334 (C.D.
 15 Cal. Dec. 18, 2025) (amended order consolidating the court’s orders on motion for partial
 16 summary judgment, class certification, and application for reconsideration or clarification);

- 18 • *Maldonado Bautista v. Santacruz*, No. 5:25-cv-1873, ECF No. 92 (C.D. Cal. Dec. 18,
 19 2025) (order granting in part and denying in part Petitioners’ ex parte application for
 20 reconsideration or clarification).

 22 of the specific questions the Court raised during the hearing held on December 18, 2025.
