The Court, after considering Plaintiffs' Unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval of Settlement and Approval of Class Notice Program, and all prior pleadings and proceedings here, hereby **ORDERS**:

- 1. The Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Settlement is GRANTED and the Settlement Agreement is preliminarily APPROVED.
- 2. The Motion for Approval of Class Notice Program is GRANTED and:
 - a. On September 2, 2020 or before, the Defendants shall ensure that the Notice to the Class (the "Notice") is posted in the common areas of all the detention centers in the Rural Counties, namely, Churchill County Detention Center, Douglas County Jail, Esmeralda County Jail, Eureka County Detentions Facility, Lander County Jail, Lincoln County Detention Center, Lyon County Jail, Mineral County Detention Facility, Nye County Detention Center, Pershing County Jail, and White Pine County Jail. The Notice shall remain posted until at least October 2, 2020. For the same period of time that the Notice is posted, Defendants shall also request that county officials personally deliver the Notice to individuals who are in custody at the Rural County facilities and unable to access the common areas.
 - b. On September 2, 2020 or before, the Defendants shall ensure that the Notice is posted in at least one visible location in every location where arraignments are held in each of the Rural Counties. The Notice shall remain posted until at least October 2, 2020. Defendants shall ensure that complete copies of the Settlement Agreement are available upon request.
 - c. On September 2, 2020 or before, the Defendants shall ensure that every judge in the Rural Counties is provided with copies of the Notice and is instructed to distribute the Notice to every criminal defendant that appears before him or her in court. The judges shall be instructed to do so until at least October 2, 2020.
 - d. On September 2, 2020 or before, the Plaintiffs shall ensure that, where available, print advertisements are taken out in local newspapers that distribute to the Rural

Counties, namely, the Las Vegas Review-Journal, Las Vegas Sun, Reno Gazette-Journal, Elko Daily Free Press, Battle Mountain Bugle, Lahontan Valley News, Nevada Legal Press, Pahrump Valley Times, the Record-Courier, and Tonopah Times-Bonanza. The print advertisements shall remain posted until October 2, 2020.

3. Written objections to or comments on the Settlement Agreement will be considered by the Court at the Fairness Hearing. All objections must be postmarked by October 22, 2020. Once received, comments and objections will be posted to the docket. All objections or comments must be marked "Objection to Class Settlement in Davis v. State of Nevada, No. 170C02271B" and sent to the Court at the address below:

- 4. On November 23, 2020 or before, briefs relating to the Settlement Approval shall be filed.
- 5. On December 14, 2020 or before, parties may file reply briefs relating to the Settlement Approval.
- 6. A fairness Hearing to address any objections or comments to the proposed Settlement Agreement shall be held on January 4, 2021 at 9:30 a.m. at the Carson City District Court, 885 East Musser Street, Carson City, Nevada 89701.
